Dear Artist,

You are invited to submit your work for the 2025 exhibition.

How to submit your work:

Each Artist may submit up to 12 works, comprising the following:

1. Up to 4 works for hanging. **All these must have secure cord or wire for hanging. We can not accept responsibility for hangings that fail.**
2. PLEASE NOTE – different hanging fees for pictures larger than 24" height or width. Maximum size 48" in either dimension.
3. Up to 4 Miniatures. Maximum size (including frame) will be 7" x 5". All these must also have cord or wire for hanging.
4. Up to 4 Unframed pictures, to be entered in our portfolio racks. We recommend that these should be mounted on mounting board and securely covered with cellophane. No canvases in this section – except thin canvas faced board.

All exhibits must be for sale, and must be completely the artist's own work. If the artist wishes to submit a print of their own work this must be stated as the medium. It is the responsibility of the artist to ensure that work copied directly from other sources is not submitted unless permission has been obtained and acknowledgements displayed in the title. We do not accept pieces made from craft kits etc. or photography.

Please ensure that all entries are clearly labelled on the back with:

- Artist's name
- Title
- Selling price

Submitting Entries: List on the entry form the works you wish to submit, giving titles, the media used and the prices to be asked. In the event that we are over-subscribed the organisers reserve the right to limit each artist to a smaller number of entries.

The completed entry form should be sent to:

These must arrive no later than **Monday 15th September 2025.**

Please make payment by cheque, payable to All Saints PCC Denmead or bank transfer to: All Saints PCC, sort code 30-99-20, a/c 00019898, ensuring you include reference ArtEx.

We do not send out confirmation of receipt of entry forms unless you specifically request this, in which case please provide an email address or an s.a.e.

Delivery of Exhibits: Please deliver the exhibits to the Church Hall between **4.30pm and 6.00pm on Friday 26th September.**

Display of Exhibits. The set-up and display of the exhibition is carried out by the organisers and their team, and we do not group artists' work together in one location except in the case of miniatures which may be displayed in sets if appropriate.

Collection of Unsold Exhibits: All unsold exhibits must be collected from the Church Hall on **Sunday 28th September** between 4.45 and 6.00pm. Please bring the receipt you will have received when the exhibits were delivered on Friday).

Payments. We will ask artists who have sold paintings to provide their bank details to enable us to make a payment for work sold. If preferred, alternatively we could pay by cheque.

Safety of Exhibits: No responsibility will be taken for loss of, or damage to, exhibits – but as in previous years great care will be taken and an all night watch will be kept on the hall.

Commission: A 20% commission will be taken on all sales.

Two A5 posters are attached. Please display these to help advertise the exhibition. If you are able to use additional A4 posters these may be downloaded from the website or obtained from All Saints Church, in the area just inside the main doors.
